SHAP provides permanent supportive housing to homeless individuals and/or families within Marion County. Services include assistance with locating appropriate affordable housing, ongoing case management, identification and assistance with barriers to employment, and financial resources for housing.

These barriers could include; disability, mental illness, substance abuse, criminal history, inadequate job skills, lack of education, abusive home environments, poor rental history, bad credit, or lack of previous rental experience and/or credit history.

SHAP Community Partners currently provide referrals for people on the streets, in shelters, malls, libraries, emergency food distribution points, and in other community settings. Shangri-La's Housing Resource Specialist works with each referred individual to ensure eligibility for permanent housing through the project.
